EndoVantage Wins Prestigious International Award

Scottsdale, AZ, October 2, 2014 – EndoVantage has won the 2014 Mimics Innovation Award in the poster category for the North and South American region. The poster details the company's technology enabling computer simulations of endovascular treatments for cerebral aneurysms. The Award includes a payment of 1,000 Euros.

The EndoVantage technology was invented at Arizona State University and Mayo Clinic Phoenix. This novel computer simulation platform enables pre-treatment planning, utilizing real patient data, state-of-the-art computational device models and fluid dynamics to simulate and thereby plan patient-specific endovascular treatments. Mechanical and fluid dynamic simulation results are then used to evaluate the outcomes of different treatment options. With it clinicians will, for the first time, design the optimal endovascular treatment strategy for each patient before surgery, improving treatment quality and reducing cost. The technology is also invaluable to medical device companies, enabling them to test their devices virtually in hundreds of different patient anatomies, aiding product development and revealing product defects and dangerous scenarios.

"This award continues a string of recent EndoVantage successes, including acceptance in ASU's Edson Entrepreneurial Initiative and winning the Arizona Commerce Authority's Innovation Challenge," stated Robert S. Green, EndoVantage's president & CEO. "We are gratified by the international recognition this award represents," Green said.

The Mimics award is given by Materialise Inc., based in Belgium, to promote innovation in medical procedures and computer-aided engineering. Each year the international competition assembles a panel of judges from industry and academia to examine bioengineering research studies from around the world. Judges take into account the potential economic and social impact of new ideas, as well as the degree of innovation and the quality of research.
